The 2017 - 2018 year has been phenomenal for the Women's Center of Jacksonville (WCJ) and the clients we serve. In addition to the kind and compassionate services provided by dedicated staff to thousands of individuals, the WCJ launched a Community Initiative (Capital Campaign) to purchase and renovate a building for the a stand alone Sexual Assault Forensic Exam Center (S.A.F.E). 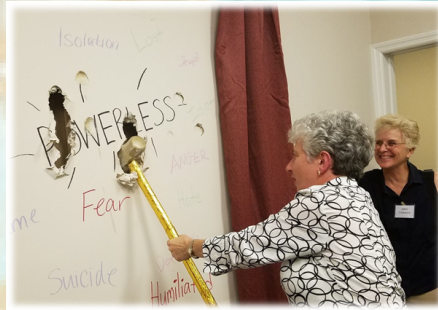

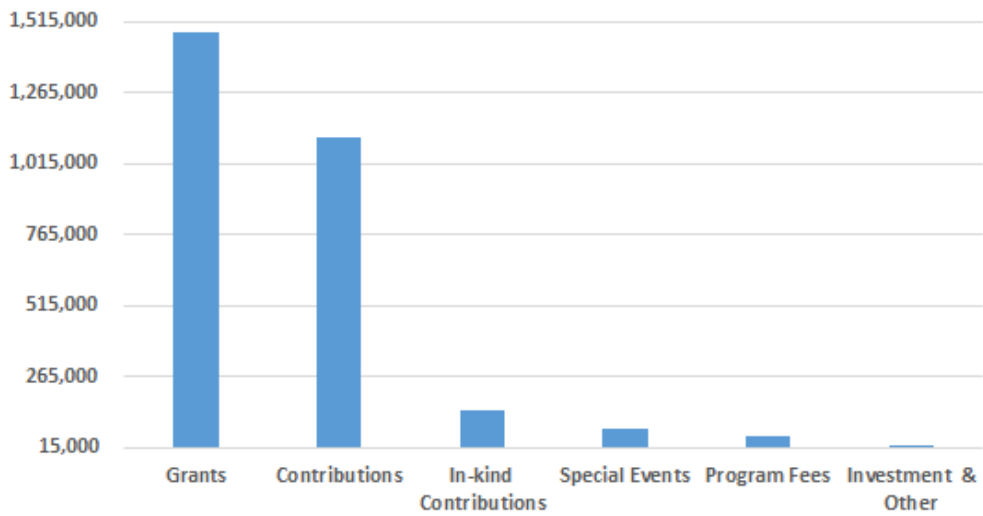

## REVENUE

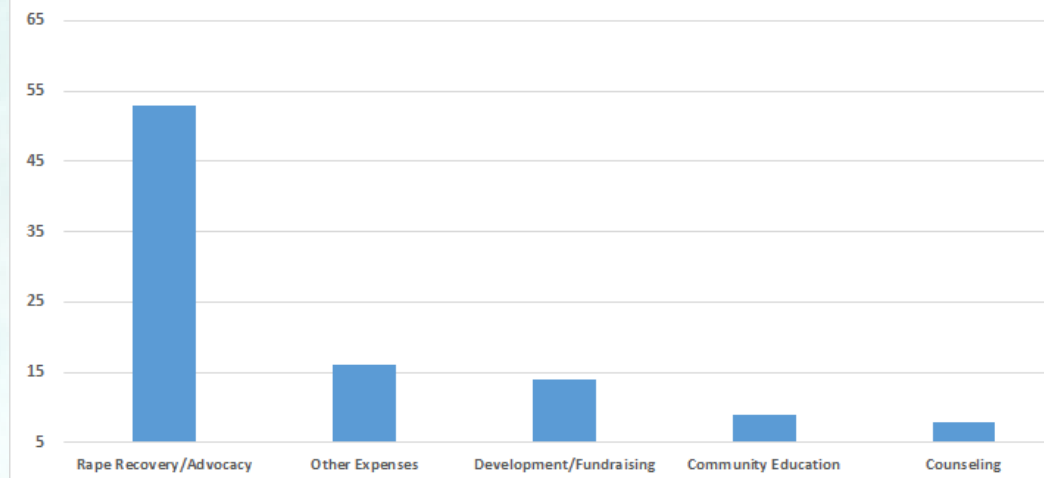
Revenue 2017-2018
